2. Why do we tend to not feel faithful, joyful and triumphant, especially around Christmas?

Read Matthew 9:12-13 and Matthew 11:28

3. Share a time in your life when you felt weary and burdened.
4. Have you ever thought to yourself, "No one can be as sinful as I am?"
5. How did you feel when you realized, that even though you were sinful, weary and burdened, Jesus was calling you?

6. In what ways is God making you new?

Pastor Kyle also shared, "Happiness depends on happenings; joy depends on Jesus. Our joy comes from a right relationship with God."

7. Can you describe a time when you felt joy even though you were facing a difficult circumstance?
