



Relationship Status Week 4: Whatever It Takes Group Discussion Notes

Leading Off:

What's the most embarrassing thing you have ever done in public?

Scripture:

*Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. **Philippians 2:5-7***

Discussion Questions:

1. If you had to classify your close friends as either "on their mark" or "not on their mark," where would the majority land?
2. What about your family? Do most of them know Christ as their personal Savior or are most of them spiritually lost?

No doubt, if one of us knew for certain we had found the cure for cancer or some other terminal disease, we'd share it with everyone who was sick or dying. Now, what keeps us from applying this same kind of thinking when it comes to our family and friends who are spiritually sick and dying without Christ?

3. What are the biggest obstacles that prevent you from sharing Christ with others?
4. Take a minute and think about your story. What *is* your story? Is there a person that went out of their way to share Christ with you? What lengths did they go to?
5. How far are *you* willing to go to reach a friend who is spiritually lost?
