Discussion Questions:

Pastor Chad shared the thought, “We are the church. And the church is the instrument through which God chooses to make His Presence known.”

1. What does the world around us look like when the church is all-in, wholly committed and fully surrendered?
2. Would you describe yourself as all-in, wholly committed and fully surrendered?

In Luke 2 it says, “[Jesus] is Christ the Lord.”

3. What does that mean for us, for you?

“Kurios” is a Greek word meaning supreme in authority; controller; Lord.

Pastor Chad shared, “There is a battle inside of you, a battle for the very heart of you – a battle between your sin nature (the selfish you) and the Spirit of God inside of you.”

4. In what area of your life do you struggle with giving up control to God? Why?
5. If you win the battle of control, what will the consequences be?

6. Do you currently live a partially surrendered life?

Read Luke 6:46 & Proverbs 3:5-6

7. If you knew God more, would you trust Him more? And if you trusted Him more, would you fully surrender yourself to His Lordship in your life?

Read Matthew 7:21-23

Pastor Chad shared, "To know [Jesus] is to be fully surrendered to His [absolute, reigning supreme and everlasting] Lordship in my life."
