Breaking the Ice:

What's your favorite thing to do in the summer?

Scripture: Psalm 1

Discussion Questions:

When sharing the importance of Psalm 1 in his life, Bobby said, "You're a product of the five people you're around the most."

1. Who are the five people you're around the most?
2. How do you feel about being a product of those five people?

When asked about his daughter's medical challenges, Bobby said, "You live your life, you pray, you're thankful for what you have. You understand that this isn't the end - it's the beginning. We're going to handle this and deal with it."

3. Share a time when you or someone close to you faced significant medical challenges.
4. How did you handle the situation?

Pastor Chad shared, "Most of the time when something challenging happens in our life ... we'll never know why ... we'll never clearly be able to understand [God's] perfect will in it."

5. Have you struggled with not being able to clearly understand God's perfect will in what was happening in your life?

Pastor Chad shared, "In the midst of uncertainty is when the certainty that you have in Christ really begins to guide you ... and [is] that comfort and peace in your life."

6. How has your relationship with Christ guided you, given you comfort and given you peace in the midst of uncertainty?

Read 1 Peter 5:5-9

When asked about what it looks like to “stand firm in the faith”, Bobby said, “There is no risk. You start reading [the Bible], you start understanding, you start opening your heart and you’ll really believe ... and understand what its all about.”
