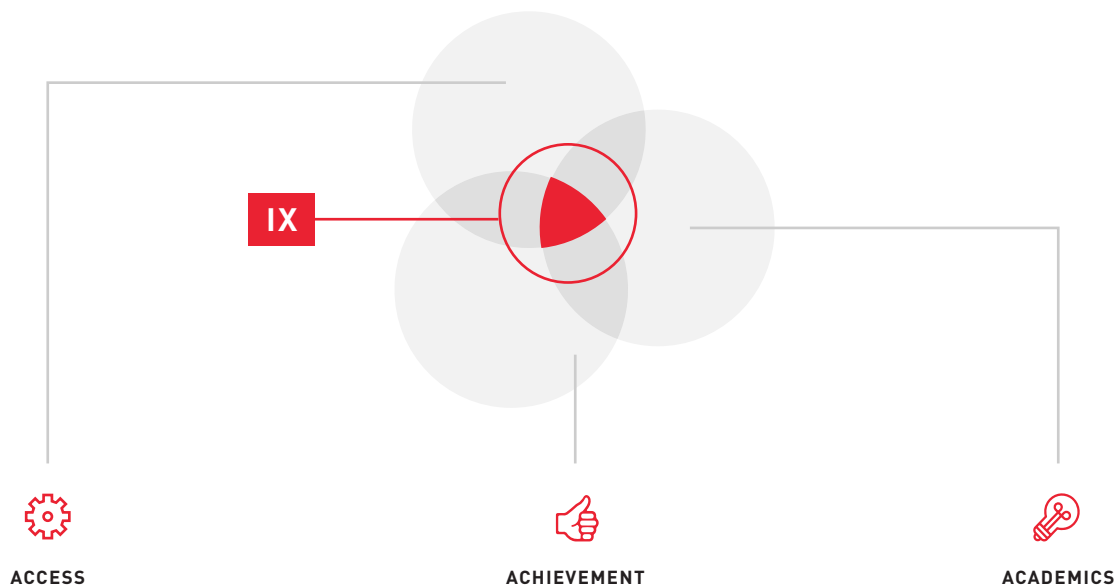
ROCK CITY INTERNSHIP EXPERIENCE

ROCK CITY IX IS BENT ON BUILDING THE NEXT GENERATION OF LIFE-GIVING LEADERS by inverting the traditional internship model. Rather than tasking, IX trains dynamic leaders through up-front access to weekly operations and ministry systems, achievement-focused responsibilities to learn ideation and troubleshooting, and academic advancement to grow in spiritual health and discipline.



BEHIND THE SCENES Spend time partnering with Rock City Staff during weekly offices hours to plan, prepare and pull off multi-campus ministry.

BEYOND OUR WALLS Be a part of changing the lives of others in our community by serving with Rock City's Beyond Our Walls events and The Columbus Dream Center.

BENEATH THE SURFACE Sharpen your gifts and talents and push past your comfort zone through one-on-one development with your Track Lead.

TRACK FOCUS Take ownership within your track and build confidence in your leadership through hands-on experience. A majority of your time will be spent in your track learning directly from your Track Leads, other leaders, and volunteers.

CELEBRATION Close your intern experience on the highest note possible with an all-class event focused on processing all you've learned and celebrating the completion of the internship season.

INTERN-ONLY CLASS Engage in weekly teaching sessions led by IX Director and Rock City Staff focused on soul health, spiritual disciplines, biblical lessons and practical application.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

HOURS & SCHEDULE

IX is designed to complement a part-time academic or employment commitment. The schedule should be established prior to the semester starting and maintained throughout the semester. If there are major changes to the schedule during the semester, the intern should be in communication with the Track Lead and Internship Director. Interns are encouraged to secure part-time employment or demonstrate financial security to support themselves throughout the duration of the semester as this is an un-paid internship. There is flexibility with the schedule.

FLEX HOURS

Designated for track-focused efforts. **Interns are required to do 2 full days (7-8 hours) or 3 half days (4-5 hours) a week.**



FIXED HOURS

Designated for intern-only classes where spiritual and personal growth are encouraged. Sunday service hours vary by track but at the minimum, interns are encouraged to serve 1 service and sit 1 service.
