FOR SMALL GROUPS WITH KIDS

*In addition to these activities, invite families to spend additional time together going through FAMILY FOUNDATIONS. This is a separate 30-minute experience that helps parents connect with their kids on the same teachings they are learning in their small group.

READ

“A man was going from Jerusalem to Jericho. Robbers hurt him and took his clothes. A priest came by but passed him on the other side of the road. A Levite passed on the other side, too. But a Samaritan helped bandage his wounds and brought him on a donkey to an inn to take care of him.”

PLAY

Have each person think of someone they can pray for. Write the name of the person on a tag. Tie the tag around the stuffed animal as a reminder to pray for this person each night. Let each child share who they will pray for and why. Spend time together praying by name for the people listed on the tags.
